CreditSnap Inc. (herein referred to as 'company', 'we', 'us') is a technology provider to financial services partners. We value your patronage and your privacy. This notice describes how we protect your privacy when we collect and use information about you provided by you through "the website" or through "our customer websites managed by CreditSnap" (together referred to as 'website', 'websites'), as well as information collected offline and the measures we take to safeguard that information. 1. What Information We Collect and Receive About You

We might receive or collect several types of information about you, such as the information described below.

- a. Personally Identifiable Information or PII: Identify you such as your name, address, telephone number, mobile number, e-mail address and social security number identifies you personally, such as your name, address, email address, Social Security number or phone number.

Information such as Social Security Number (SSN), date of birth (DOB), address and phone number may be verified to assist in the prevention of identity theft, consumer identification and verification by third party services. Company takes your privacy seriously and performs these checks using industry best practices and standards. We may also collect information about you from sources other than you, such as from social media websites i.e., Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter or others with your consent.
- c. Automatic Collection, Cookies and Other Internet Technologies: We use cookies and other standard internet technologies to collect information from your computer and about your activities on the website. We automatically collect Non-PII from your browser when you visit the website. This information includes, but is not necessarily limited to your IP address, your browser type and language, access times, the content of any undeleted cookies that your browser previously accepted from us and the referring website address. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record keeping purposes. 3. How We Use Information

We may use the information we collect from you for various lawful business purposes such as finding the available credit options, communicating with you, conducting research and development to improve or enhance our Services and our users' experience, and promote our Services. We may use information to:

- a. Deliver the products and services you requested.
- b. Perform functions as described to you at the time of collection.
- c. Manage your customer relationship to provide you with customer support
- d. Communicate with you via e-mail, postal mail and/or SMS to your mobile device about products or services that may be of interest to you
- e. Build and display content and services customized to your interests on the website and other websites
- f. Targeted advertisements and measure the overall effectiveness of our online advertising, content, programming and other activities
- g. We may use financial information to provide you with conditional loan offers, as well as to verify your identity, protect against or identify possible fraudulent transactions, or otherwise as needed to manage our business.

4. With Whom Do We Share Your Information

- a. Services Providers: We may share your personal information with our authorized service providers that perform certain services on our behalf including, but not limited to service providers that perform services on our behalf in connection with your request for a loan or the funding, sale and/or servicing of your loan. These third parties include, without limitation credit bureaus, other insurance companies, closing agents, marketing and customer services firms, credit card, or entities that provide business analysis or website support. These third parties may have access to PII needed to perform their functions.
- c. Other Situations: We also may disclose your information at our sole discretion
 - I. In response to a subpoena or similar investigative demand, a court order or a request for cooperation from a law enforcement or other government agency; to establish or exercise our legal rights; to defend against legal claims; or as we reasonably believe is required by law. In such cases, we may raise or waive any legal objection or right available to us
 - II. In connection with a substantial corporate transaction, such as the sale
 of our business, a divestiture, merger, consolidation, asset sale or in the
 unlikely event of bankruptcy.
 - III. When we believe disclosure is appropriate in connection with efforts to investigate, prevent or take other action regarding actual or suspected

illegal activity or other wrong doing; to protect and defend the rights, property or safety of our company, our users, our employees or others; or to enforce the websites terms and conditions or other agreements or policies.

5. How we Protect Your PII

 We take industry standard security measures (including physical, electronic and procedural measures) to help safeguard your PII from unauthorized access and disclosure. In addition to the restrictions outlined above, we require employees to comply with information security safeguards, we use encryption in the transmission of your PII between your system and ours, and we use firewalls to help prevent unauthorized persons from gaining access to your PII.

Encryption & website certificates	Industry standard encryption protects the information you share with us from the moment it leaves your computer until it reaches our systems. Session time-outs	We employ session time-outs to protect your account. You will be logged out of the website automatically after a period of inactivity. This reduces the risk of others being able to access your account if you leave your computer unattended.

We will never ask for this information by phone or email.
